SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: Saturday: 3:30-4:30PM

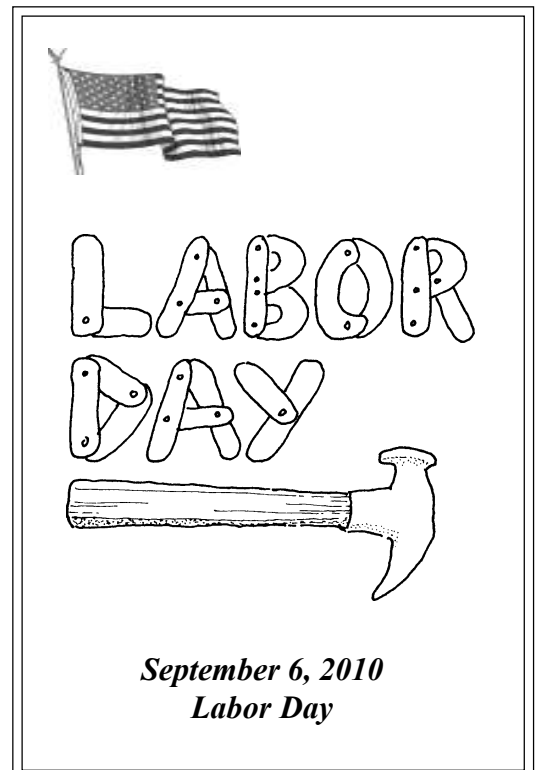
SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: First Fridays following the 9:00AM Mass. Angelus and Benediction at Noon.

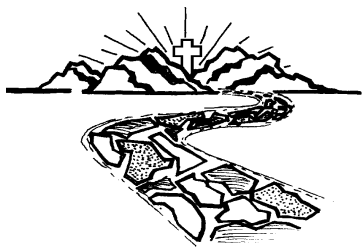
NOVENA: Miraculous Medal - Mondays - following the 9:00AM Mass.
