### Liturgy of the Hours: Week IV of the Psalter Reflection on the Gospel

When Jesus heals, he doesn't simply restore people to a former state of well-being. Rather, physical healings are outer signs of deeper transformation of body, mind, and spirit, and nothing is ever the same afterward. When Jesus heals her fever, Simon's mother-in-law experiences a "resurrection." The Verb egeiro, "lifted up" (Mark 1:31), is the same word the gospels use for Jesus's resurrection. A new life has been given her, but not for her only. As with all disciples, it is a transformed life that is a transformed life that is to be shared in service.

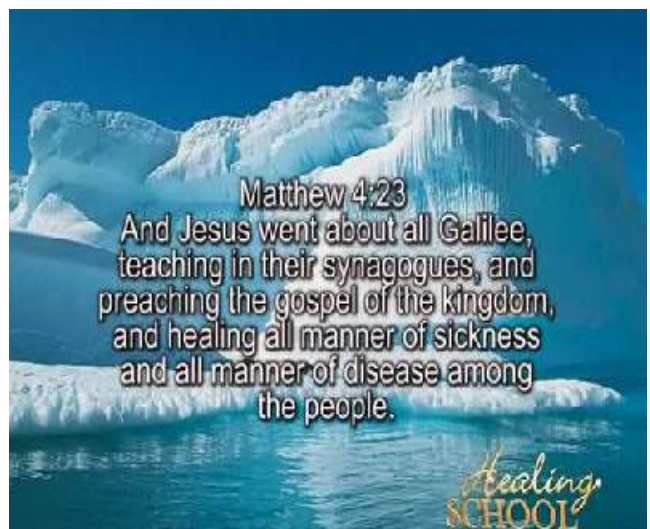
