SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Sick calls any day or night by calling the Rectory.

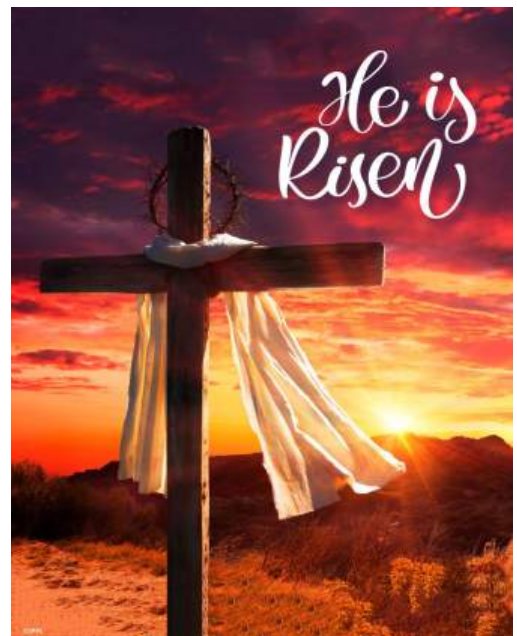
EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: First Fridays, following the 9:00 am Mass. Angelus and Benediction at 11:00am.

ROSARY: Daily, following the 9:00 am Mass.

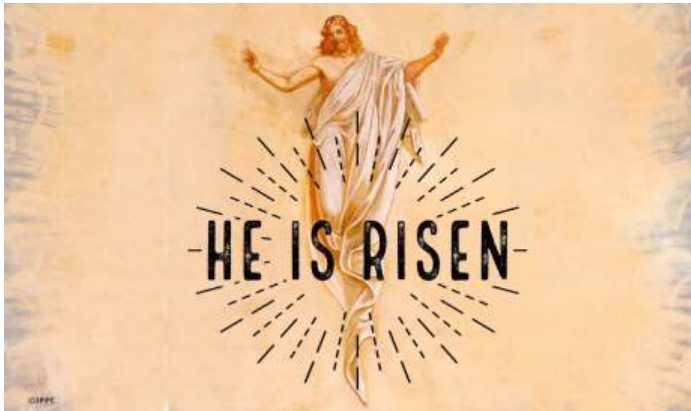
PRAYER GROUP: Wednesdays, following the 9:00 am Mass.

Where is Jesus now? In John 20, there are two parts to the answer. On Easter morning, we hear the first half: he has returned to the Father (20:1-9), At Mass on Tuesday, we'll hear the second half. Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene and sends her to the gathered community of disciples: there is where he's to be found alive (20:17). A gospel the began with "the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us" (1:14) concludes with the Word becoming en-fleshed in each individual believer and in the faith community.

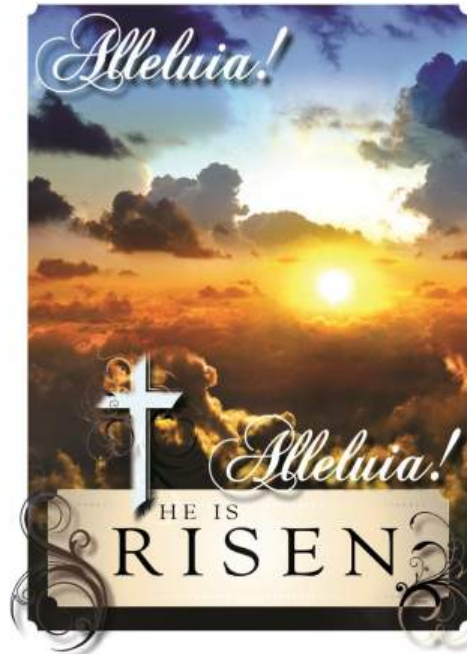

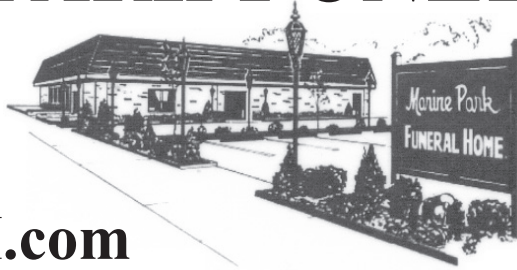
